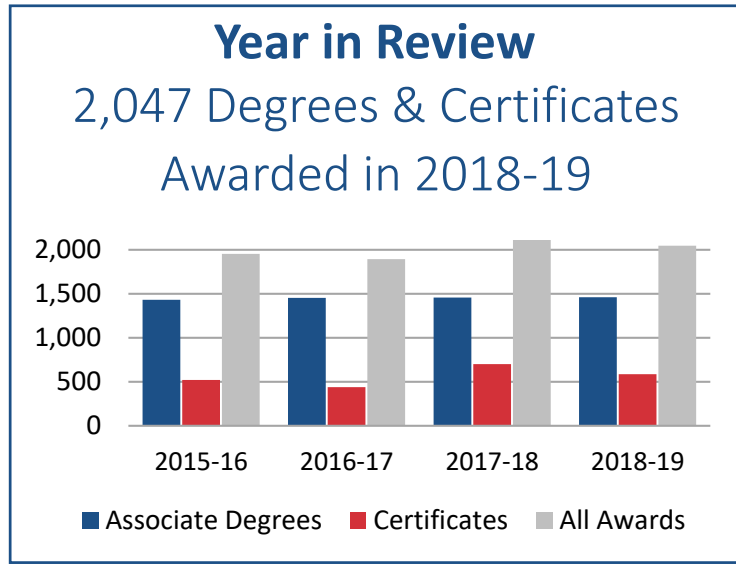


About Pellissippi State

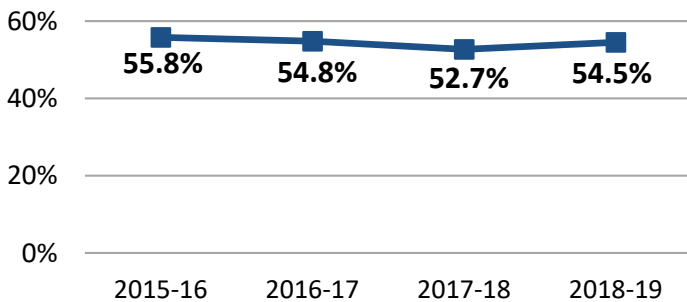

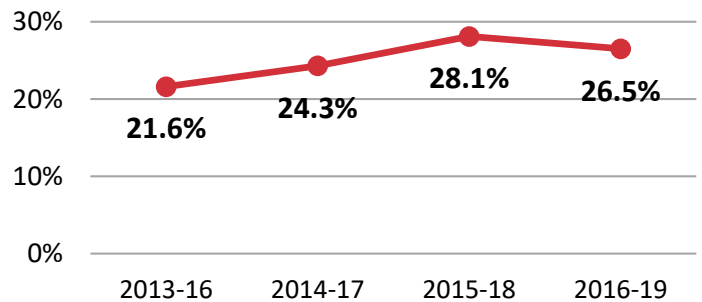
First-Year Retention Rate

TBR Community College System: 25.3% for 2016-19

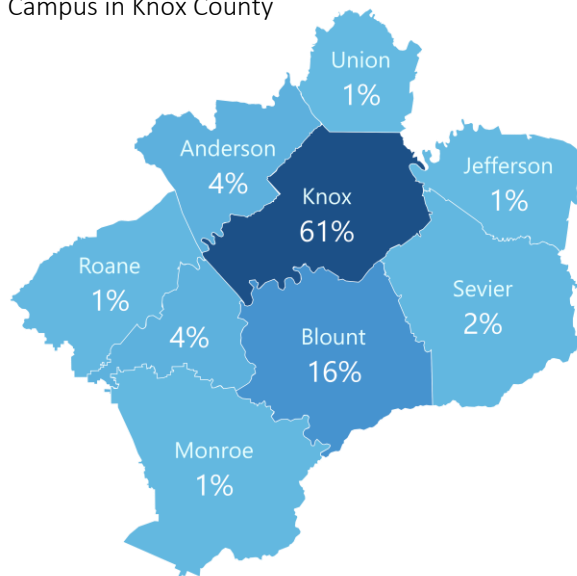
Percent of first-time, full-time students from each cohort who earned a degree or certificate at a TBR community college within 3 years.
