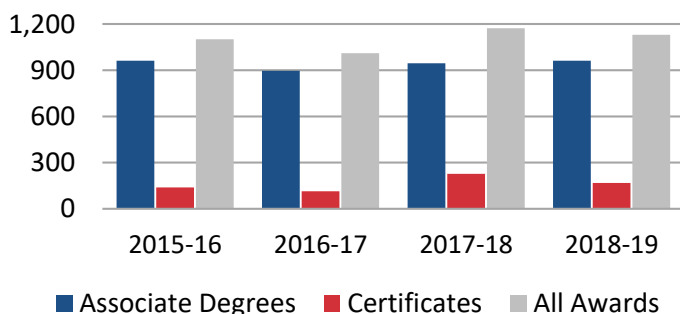


### About Roane State

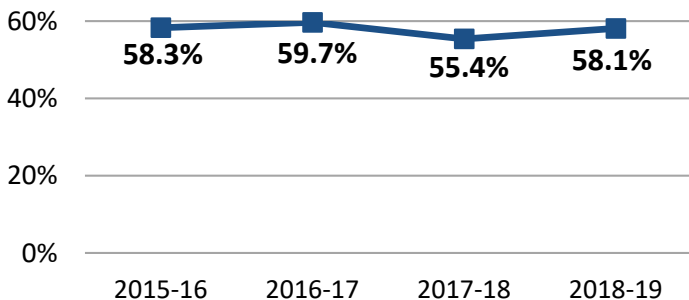

### Student Success

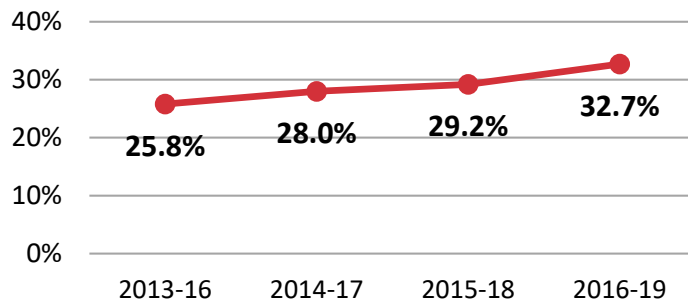
#### First-Year Retention Rate

Percent of first-time, full-time students from each cohort who earned a degree or certificate at a TBR community college within 3 years.

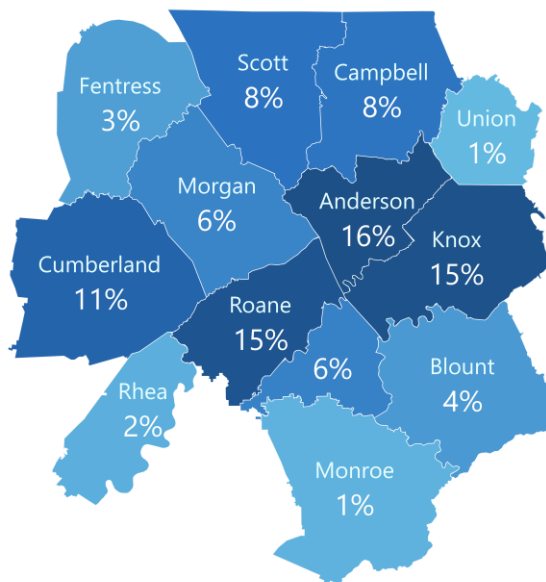
