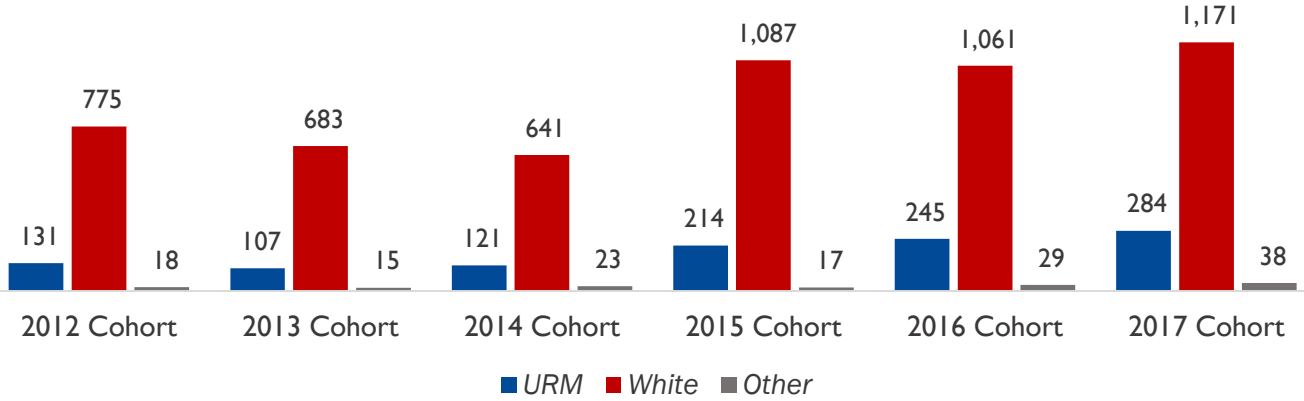
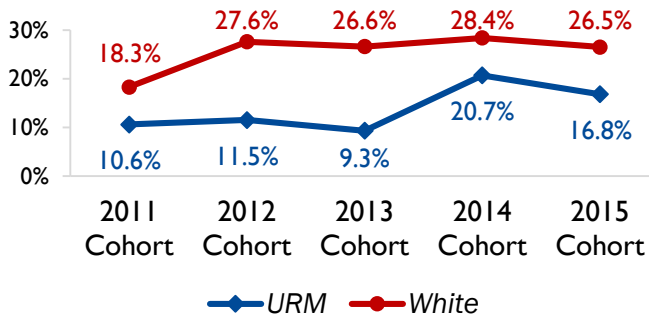


## First-time Freshmen Enrollment

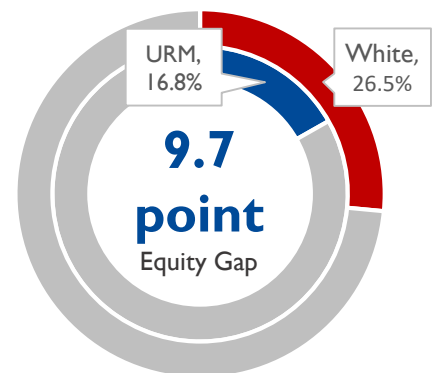

### Three-Year Graduation Rate – 2015 Cohort

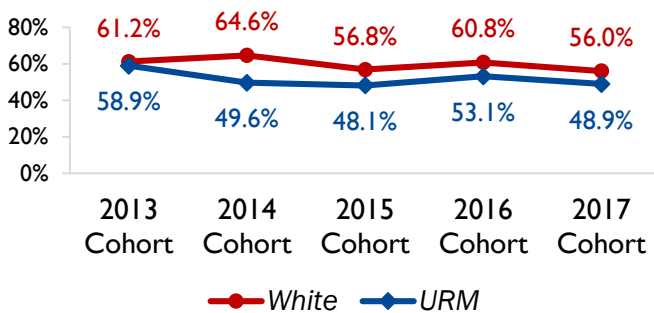

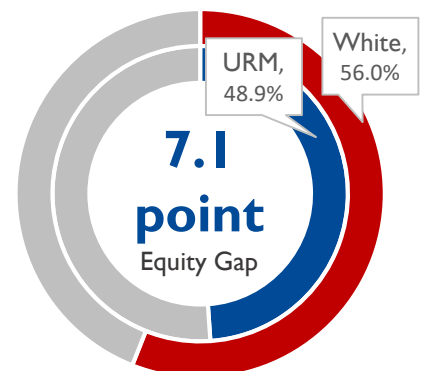

### First-Year Retention Rate – 2017 Cohort

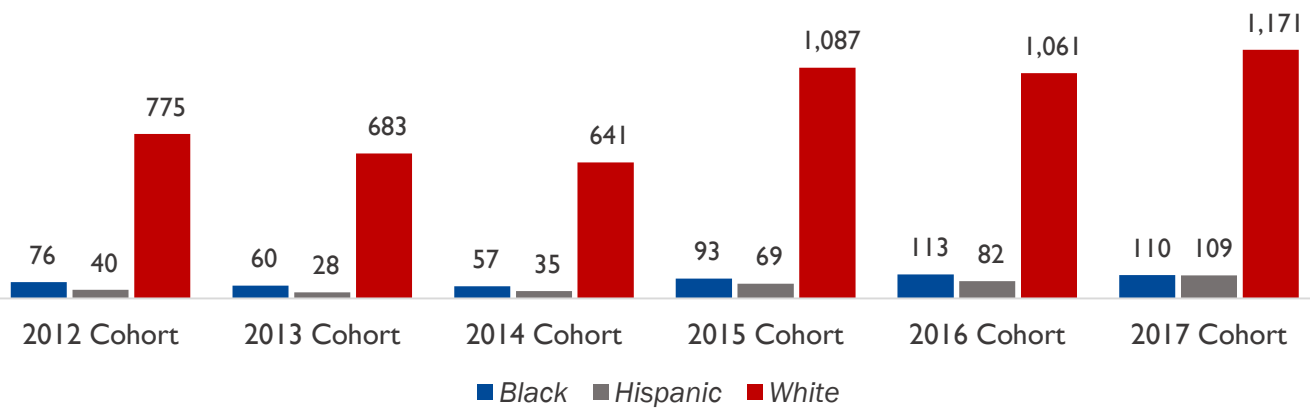

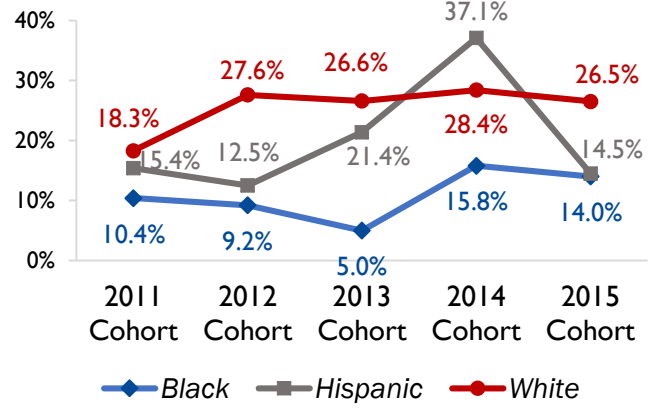
Retention rate: Percent of cohort who continued the next fall or graduated within a year.

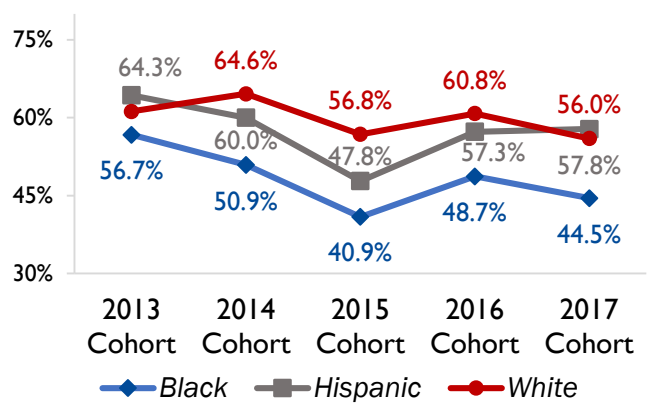
