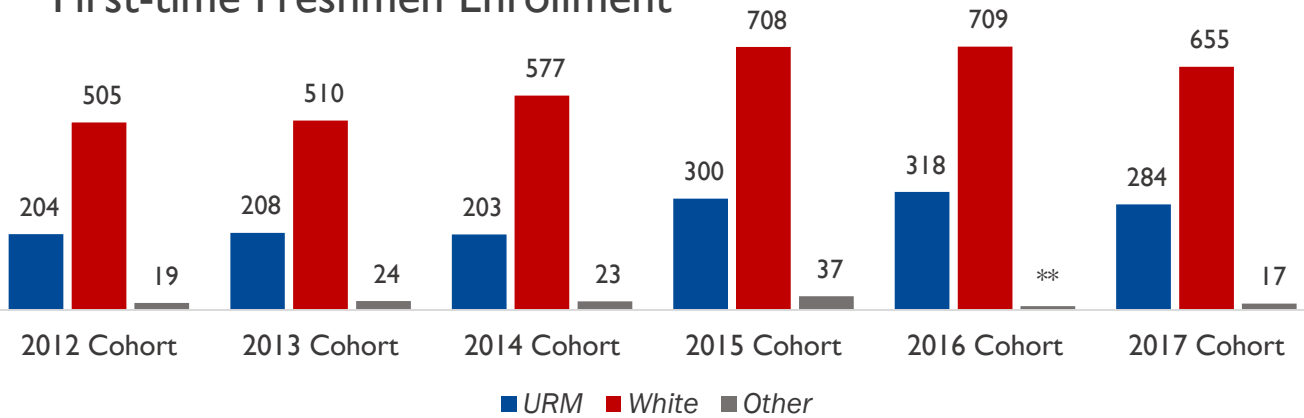
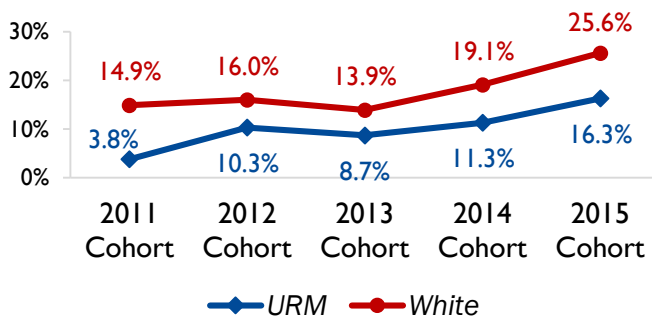


### First-time Freshmen Enrollment

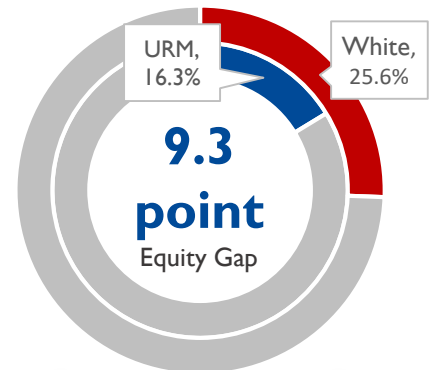

### Three-Year Graduation Rate – 2015 Cohort

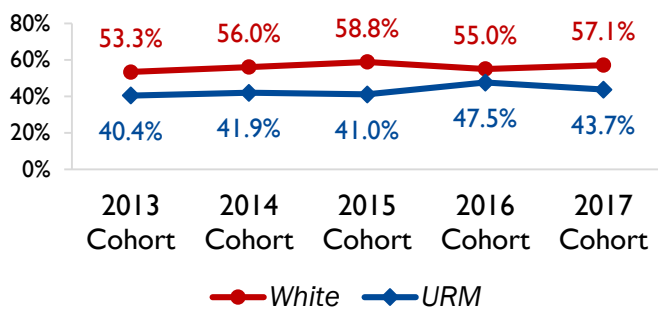

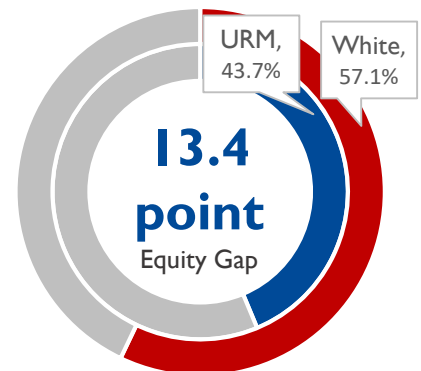

### First-Year Retention Rate – 2017 Cohort

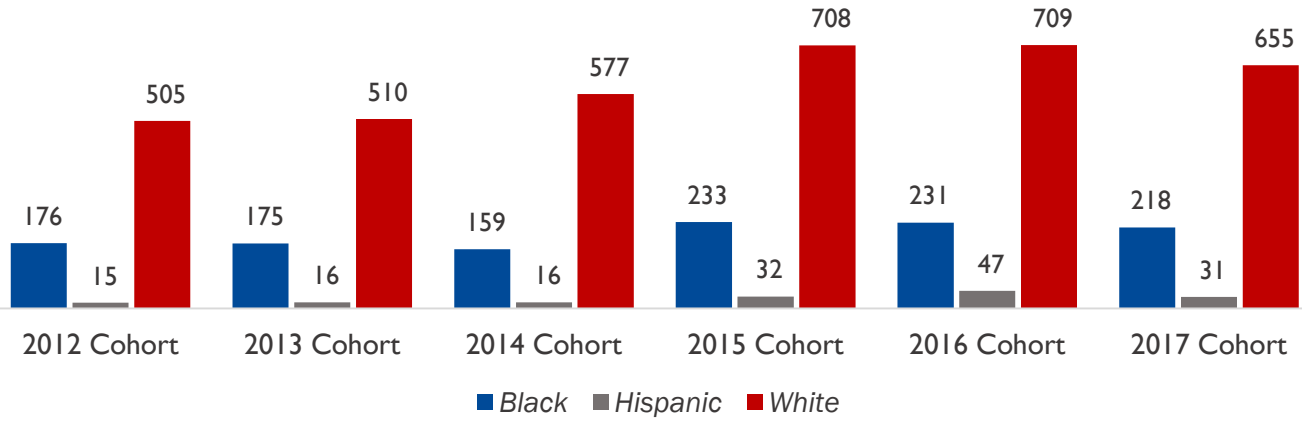

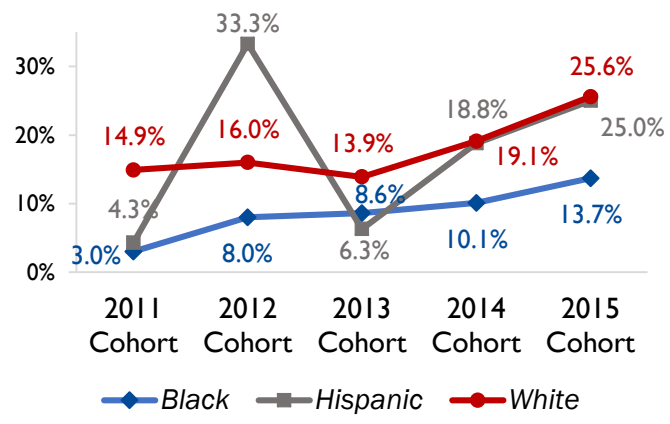

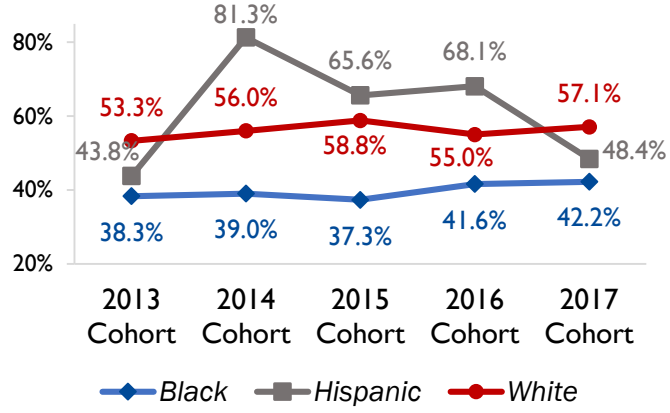
