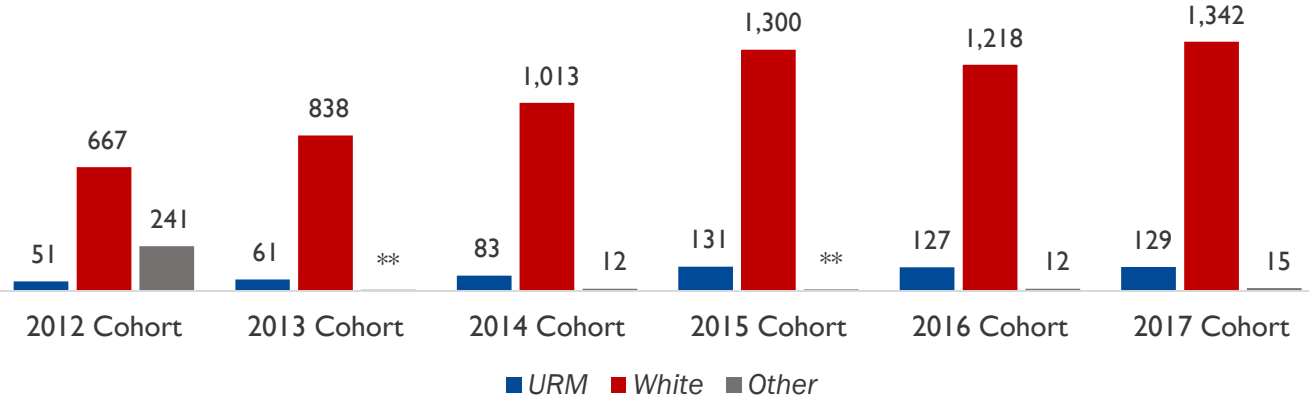
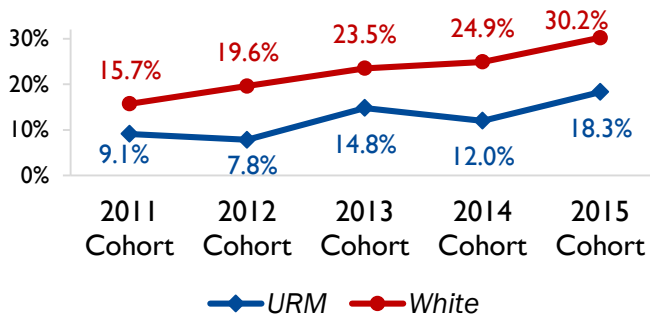

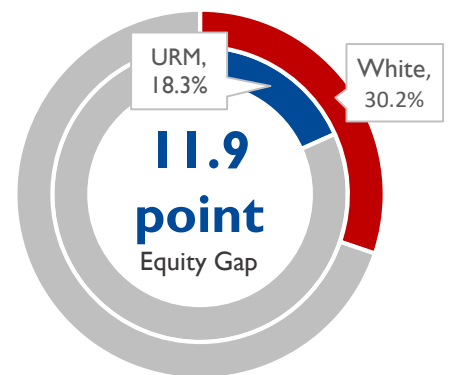

Three-Year Graduation Rate – 2015 Cohort

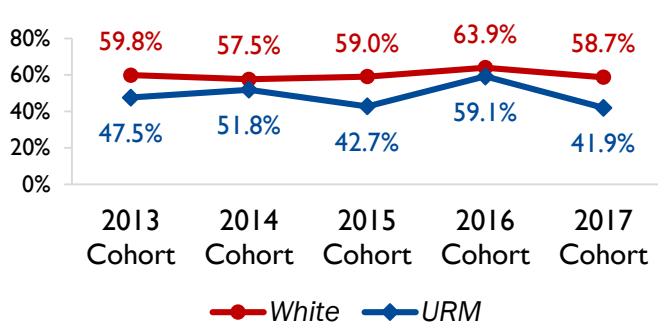

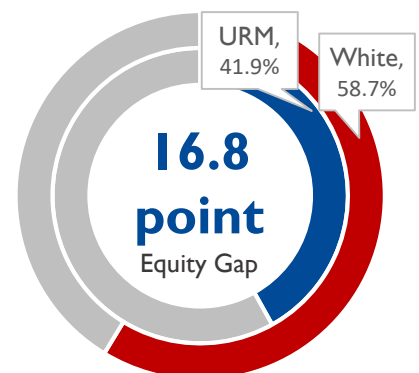

First-Year Retention Rate – 2017 Cohort

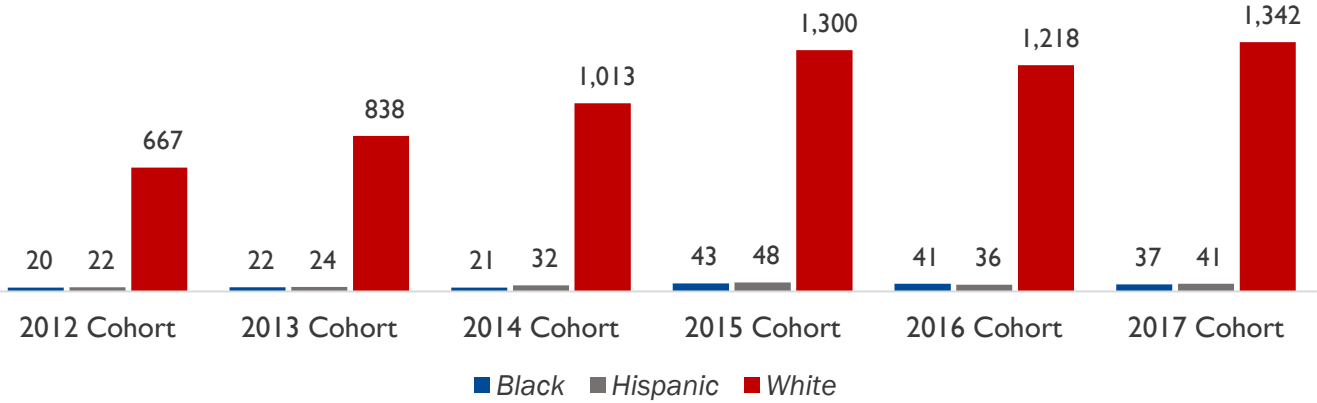

Retention rate: Percent of cohort who continued the next fall or graduated within a year.

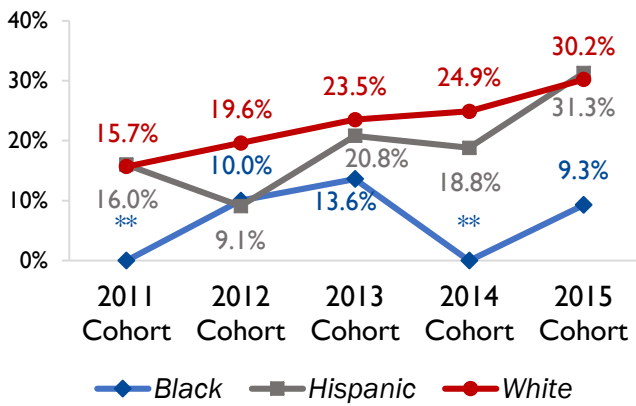
First-time Freshmen Enrollment

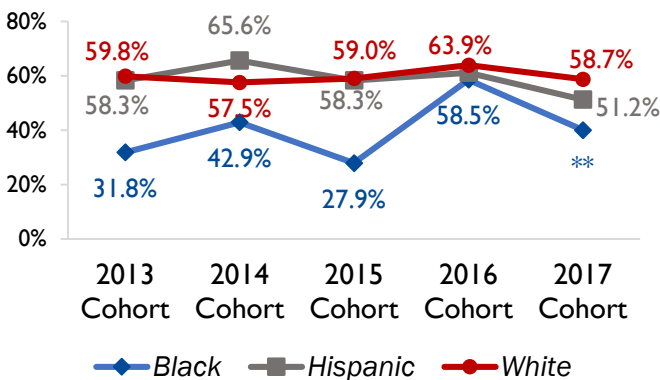
