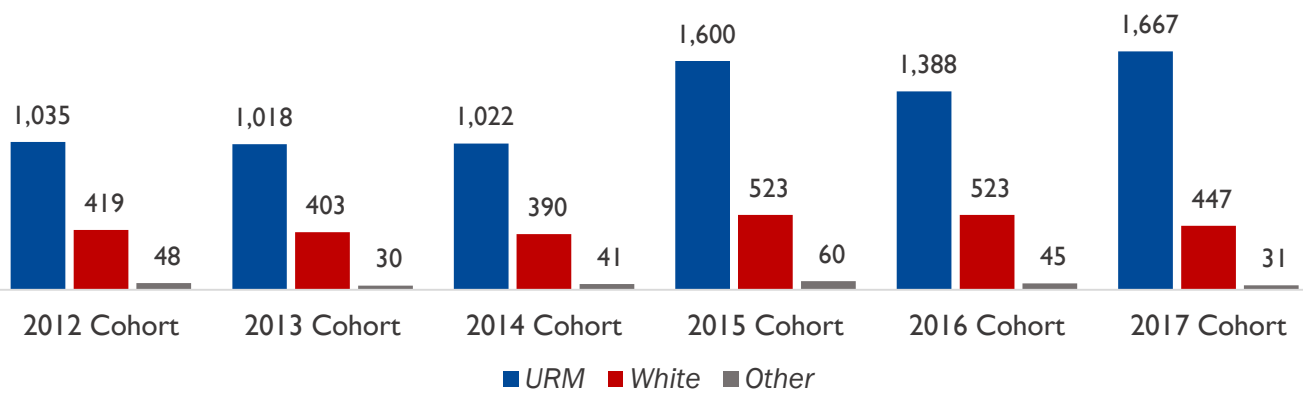
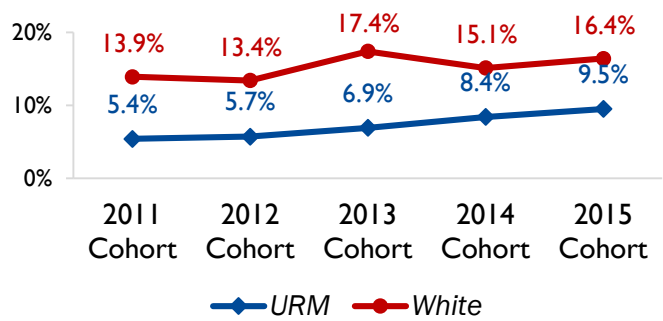

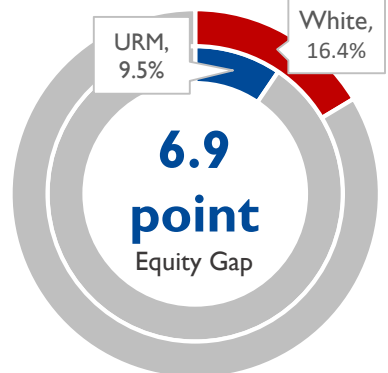

Three-Year Graduation Rate – 2015 Cohort

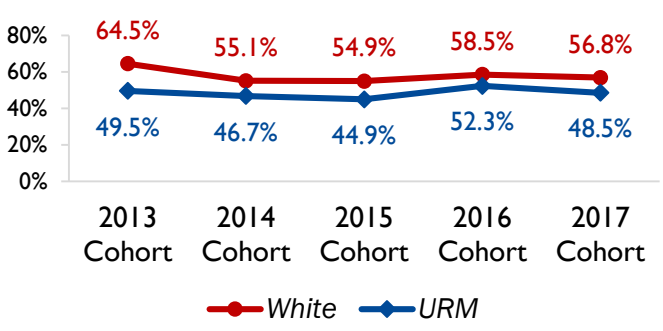

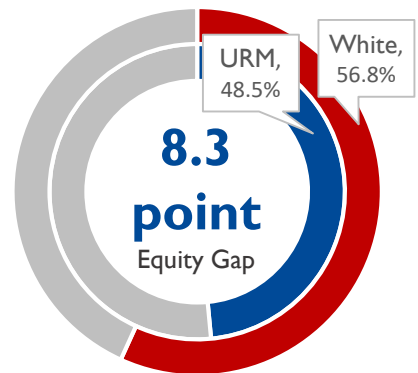

First-Year Retention Rate – 2017 Cohort

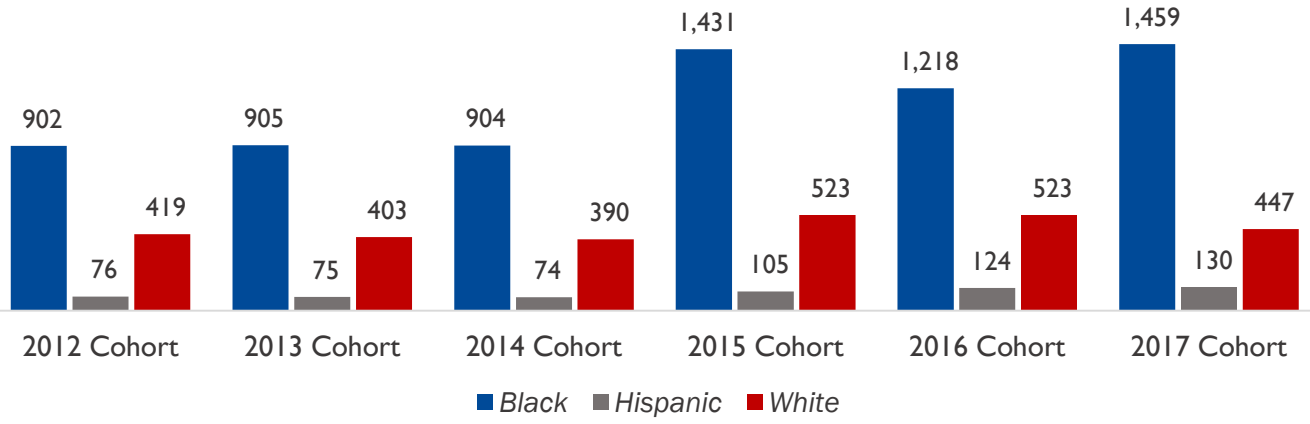

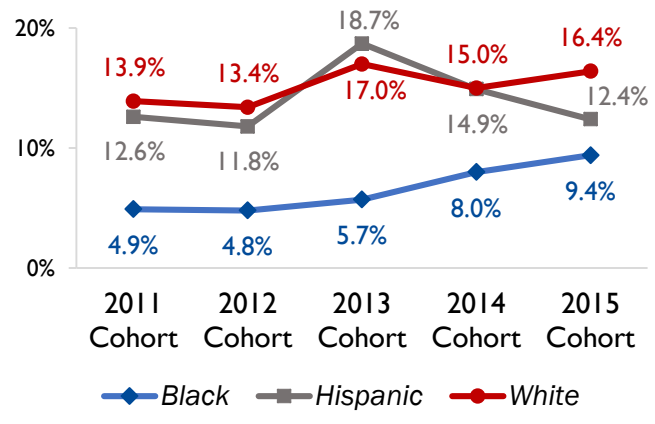

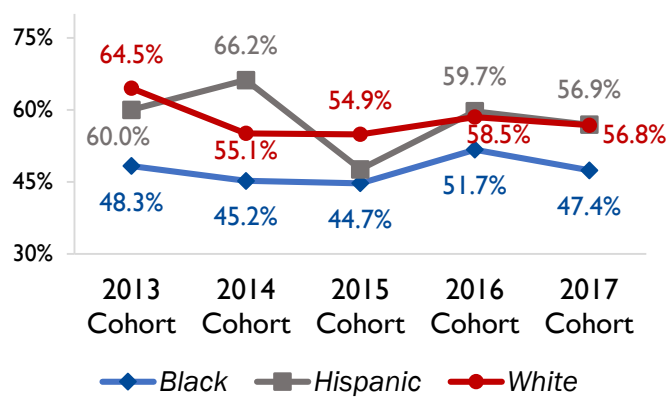
