Description of Issue: Discount Rate for Summer Terms

Based on a recent survey, it appears that some schools are discounting summer semester hours enrolled above 12. When we first switched from a cap to the discounted hours, it was felt that unless a student enrolled in all summer terms at the same time, it would be impossible to track hours enrolled across summer terms and we elected to not apply the discounted rate during the summer terms. Evidently, this was not communicated clearly to everyone at the BASC at which it was discussed. To complicate the issue, the language in B-060 regarding summer semesters says "may" instead of "shall" or "must".

Recommended Course of Action (if any): BASC needs to either affirm that no one should apply the discount rate for summer terms, determine that we will apply the discount rate during summer terms, or that we will allow each school to determine whether or not the discount rate will apply to summer semesters.
