College presidents have also recognized that over this same period of time, in addition to cost increases, there has been a significant increase in the dependency and use of technology in the classrooms and labs as well as in providing various support services to students. Additionally, given the increased sophistication and frequency of cyber attacks in today's world, our colleges are making more investments in cyber security solutions for the protection of their networks and data than ever before.

While the TAF program has allowed for significant investments in this area since FY 2000-01, it has not kept pace with inflation. CPI has increased 38.4% since last TAF increase.
